1. Alton Gaskill opened the meeting at 12:10.
2. WTD Bargaining Update. At the June 29<sup>th</sup> meeting, the County did not come forward with a complete response to the discovery request on a ULP that potentially affects the contract negotiations. Roger sent Jim Cline paperwork regarding the ULP today. Roger will meet with Jim to discuss.
3. Transit Bargaining Update. Arbitration was completed. Briefs due by August 11, unless extended. [Update: extended to end of August] Arbitrator decision is expected within 60 days of submittal of briefs. Then the County writes up the contract, both sides review and agree, then contract goes to County Executive for signature.
4. Treasurer's Report: Checking account has \$219,795 and Money Market has \$56,719. A check for copying costs for the arbitration hearing will be about \$5000.
5. Grievance Committee. All new volunteers were voted in by the Board. Don Marable raised a separate legislative issue he had been reading about, concerning Parental leave vs. FMLA. Roger said that new legislation could cause us to be out of compliance and thus causing a reopening of bargaining. The Unfair Labor Practice filed about the PPM position needs to go to a hearing. Discussion of what constitutes "working out of class"; depends on amount of work and length of time.
