1. Michael Sands opened the meeting.
2. WTD Bargaining Update. A Grievance Arbitration and Unfair Labor Practices Hearing is being scheduled for February 2018. TEA received a draft copy of the Master Labor Agreement.
3. Transit Bargaining Update. The briefs from each side in the arbitration process have been filed. We are currently waiting for the Arbitrator to respond. Both partisan representatives provided input to the Arbitrator.
4. Treasurer's Report. There are two outstanding bills, one for arbitration and one for the annual meeting & election expenses. A motion was made to evaluate the appropriateness of the amount of dues.
5. New business. At the Board meeting on October 11, a member asked about the Bylaws Committee. Will the proposed modifications be provided to the membership prior to the vote on the changes? (The answer is yes.)

The food at the Annual Meeting was very popular.

There is a proposal to make Transit its own Department instead of a division of Transportation. A member requested that TEA keep apprised of the progress of that effort. A member expressed concern about what is the work that TEA members perform.

Labor/Management meeting schedule: Transit is the third Thursday of the month and Wastewater is ad hoc.
