WW Bargaining Update:

Next bargaining team meeting is scheduled for 1/23.

- Q. Do we want to have separate bargaining committees for staff and supervisors?
General sense from the supervisors present was that we ultimately would need separate bargaining teams/sessions, but we should start the bargaining process as a joint effort.

Motion (Madden/Davison) to confirm the list of supervisors eligible to vote on the WW supervisor contract: JB, PB, RB, JB, PE, SH, PL, KL, SM, GS, GS, LW. Approved.

Motion (Madden/Davison) In light of KC's failure to respond to TEA's 8/21/07 letter regarding TEA's assertion to bargain the decision and effects of the ReOrg, TEA should file a ULP. Friendly amendment: Roger will send an email to WW management to remind them of TEA's request (8/21/07) to bargain the decision and effects of the ReOrg and that failure to resolve the issues in a timely way would force TEA to file a ULP Complaint. Approved.
